

Recently Completed Projects (December 2006)

Universal Music Group – Office Redevelopment, Kensington, London.

The brief from Universal Music was challenging as it required bringing together six major records labels, each with their own identity, into one building.

The concept was to create an 'urban' feel without being too corporate and provide a new head office which reflects their status as the global leader in the music industry. The project involved coordination with the Landlord's shell and core works as well as designing and managing the fit-out of 6300m² of office space on eight floors in a former multi-storey car park and office building.

A double height reception area and adjacent licensed café provide exciting and informal meeting spaces. The café opens into a full height atrium with an open glass and timber staircase and bridge links to all levels. The decked roof terraces provide panoramic views across London.

The result is an edgy and eclectic workplace designed to bring out the best in their creative workforce.
